- 3. Duties Joint research and general research activities at the Center for Experimental Economics
- 4. Recruit date planned: April 1, 2017
- 5. Term of position: Until March 31, 2018 (The term of the position is 1 year, in principle. A performance review would be done in the case of a contract renewal.)
- 6. Salary: In accordance with the "Kansai University Post-Doctoral Fellow (PD) Treatment Outline". 266,000 to 323,000 yen/month (Assessed by salary treatment standards, includes tax. No payment of allowances such as such as bonuses or transportation costs.)
- 7. Work conditions: 4 or more days/week, 40 hours of work, in principle Not possible to do other part time work in the university, nor other full time work outside the university.
- 8. Work place: Kansai University, Senriyama Campus (Osaka, Japan)
- 9. Application qualifications: A person who obtained a PhD, or a person who withdrew from obtaining course credits in a graduate school doctoral course, and has the ability to obtain a PhD.

We are especially seeking a person who can exhibit the following abilities in work.

- At our center, collect economic behavior data of adults, focused on the elderly. To do that, research will also be done outside the campus, in addition to at the work location written above, so the person should be able to do that. (There will be business trips where the person must stay in lodging, in which case all such business trip costs will be paid for)
- (2) Person who has skills to do experimental research. Specifically, a person who has multiple of the following: variety of knowledge about economics and psychology, knowledge about PC networks, z-Tree and other programming knowledge.

Proficiency desirable in at least 2 of these fields: experimental economics, behavioral economics, econometrics, social psychology, evolutionary psychology, mathematical biology, social simulation.

- 12. Selection method: Document screening and interview. Notification of the interview exam will be sent to the email of only that person.
 The applicant is responsible for his/her transportation costs. Selection starts when the application documents arrive, and note that we may reach the number of people to recruit before the application deadline.
